Spider web—the small, alternating shell pattern in this shoulder wrap—looks like vintage lace. Made of lightweight microfiber yarn, the wrap is not only ultrasoft and feminine, but also warm. Lion Brand® Microspun Delicate Web Wrap

Pattern Number: HookedThrows

SKILL LEVEL: Advanced Beginner

SIZE: One Size

25" x 60" (63.5 x 152.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jul 18, 2007)

Row 1: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc, ch 1), work 1 dc in first sc, sk 1 dc, 1 sc in next dc (center of shell), sk next dc, *[1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in next sc, sk 1 dc, 1 sc in next ~~sc~~ dc, sk next dc, rep from * across, end [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in last st (17 full shell CL and a half shell on each end), turn.

MATERIALS

- 910-124 Lion Brand Microspun: Mocha
8 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

4 shell clusters = 4" (10 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES:

Wrap is worked in one piece.

To create the staggered placement of shells from row to row, odd rows beg and end with a half CL (cluster), even rows beg and end with a full CL.

WRAP

Ch 110.

Foundation row: Starting in second ch from hook, work 1 sc, * sk 2 ch, [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in next ch (shell CL made), sk 2 ch, 1 sc in next ch, rep from * across, end 1 sc in last ch (18 shell CL).

Row 1: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc, ch 1), work 1 dc in first sc, sk 1 dc, 1 sc in next dc (center of shell), sk next dc, *[1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in next sc, sk 1 dc, 1 sc in next dc, sk next dc, rep from * across, end [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in last st (17 full shell CL and a half shell on each end), turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, work 1 sc in first dc, * [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in next sc, sk 1 dc, 1 sc in next dc, rep from * across, end sk 1 dc, [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in next sc, 1 sc in next dc, 1 sc in third ch of tch (18 full shell CL), turn.

Rep rows 1 and 2 until wrap is 58" (147 cm) long, do not fasten off.

Border

With right side facing you, ch 3, work 2 dc in same st (this is half of the first corner). Working along long edge of wrap, * work [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in next sp (created by turning chains), 1 sc in next sp, rep from * to bottom, [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in last st (second corner), rep from * working along foundation ch to last st, work corner in last st, cont up other long edge, work corner in last st, cont along top edge, ending with 3 dc in same st as beg, join with SI st to form last corner, fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends.
