Donation Discussion Assessment Tool: SIX Triggers

Family Mentions Donation

They want to donate or expresses an interest in talking about it

Brain Death Pronounced: Family Verbalizes Understanding

Patient has been pronounced brain dead. Family has been given this information, and express an understanding their loved one has died.

Decision to Limit, Decelerate or WD
Therapies

Team maintains therapies until there has been a donation discussion. Withdrawal or deceleration should not occur until there is a donation decision.

Family Understands There Is No Hope For Recovery

This may occur prior to brain death pronouncement or during family care plan meetings

Pulmonary or Hemodynamic Instability (On the Verge of Coding)

This could impact the patient/family donation opportunity. Team should fully support until there is a donation discussion.

Team
Mentions Donation

The donation discussion should be a coordinated effort, led by GOL in collaboration with the Team. Refrain from discussing donation without GOL involvement
