Gift of Life Donor Program *Philadelphia, Pennsylvania USA*













- Non-Profit OPO/Tissue Recovery/Eye Bank
- Established in 1974
- Federally designated OPO (Medicare) for eastern PA, Southern NJ & Delaware
 - 126 Acute Care Hospitals
 - 13 Transplant Centers, 36 Programs
 - 11.3 Million Population
- **690 organ donors in 2022**, resulting in 1,744 organ transplants (**61 donors/MM** and **154 transplants/MM**); 2,437 tissue donors, including 1,348 musculoskeletal donors and 1,974 cornea donors
- More than 58,000 organs coordinated for transplantation and over 2,000,000 tissue allografts










Gift of Life Donor Program Primary Services

- 24 hour on-call assistance and on-site response to evaluate and manage potential organ donors
- Lead organ and tissue donation conversations with families and coordinate the informed authorization process
- Coordinate surgical recovery of organs and tissues and allocate organs per UNOS guidelines
- Provide comprehensive bereavement aftercare program for all donor families
- Assist with the development of policies and procedures
- Provide professional and public education

Gift of Life Howie's House



Gift of Life Howie's House serves as a "home away from home" for transplant patients and their families by providing temporary, affordable lodging, meals, and supportive services to those who travel to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania for transplant-related care.

Who can stay at the Family House?

Solid organ transplant recipients and their families or solid organ living donors:

- Pre-transplant appointments
- During transplantation
- Post-transplant appointments
- Transplant related hospitalizations and appointments



Transplant Pregnancy Registry International

- The Transplant Pregnancy Registry International (TPR) joined the Gift of Life Institute early February 2013
- Established in 1991 by Dr. Vincent T. Armenti to study the outcomes of pregnancies in female organ transplant recipients and those fathered by male organ transplant recipients
- 2,900+ recipients of kidney, liver, liver-kidney, pancreas, heart, lungs, and small bowel have participated in study

- Any age or athletic ability!






