



Team Information

Team Philadelphia is a group of transplant recipients, living donors, donor families, and supporters from the eastern half of Pennsylvania, southern New Jersey and Delaware who attend the Transplant Games of America every other summer. The Transplant Games is an Olympic-style competition for recipients and living donors of all ages to promote the success of transplantation, to raise awareness for the urgent need of organ and tissue donation and to honor donors and their families who have so generously given the gift of life.

Competitive events are open to organ, tissue and corneal transplant recipients, living donors and bone marrow recipients. Donor families are invited to attend special events including Transplant Workshops, the Donor Tribute Ceremony, a butterfly release and much more.

The Transplant Games are much more than an athletic event. They are a celebration for all those whose lives were touched by organ and tissue donation and transplantation. The Transplant Games will bring together more than 9,000 participants from around the United States with one common goal: to raise awareness of the need for organ and tissue donation and to increase the number of registered organ, tissue and eye donors.

Team Member Expectations

Beyond the fun of participating in the Transplant Games of America, membership on Team Philadelphia is about saving and improving lives. By promoting organ, tissue and cornea donation and sharing success stories of transplantation, Team Philadelphia members help increase donation and the number of organs and tissues available for transplant. Team members are expected to support this mission by:

- Participating in public awareness events leading up to and after the Games
- Involving the community through participation or sponsorship of the Team
- Volunteering and raising funds to support Team Philadelphia
