Who is an Athlete?

- <u>Division I</u>: Solid Organ Transplant Recipients
- <u>Division II</u>: Living Donors, Corneal & Tissue Recipients, Bone Marrow Recipients
 - NOTE: DII athletes cannot compete in the followingvolleyball, basketball, table tennis, tennis, and badminton These competitions are reserved for division 1 athletes.
- Physician's approval to compete must be signed no earlier than four months prior to the start of the Transplant Games (March 5, 2024)
- To compete, a competitor's most recent transplant, or donation must have occurred on or prior to **October 5, 2023**
- Any age or athletic ability!





Athlete Rules and Regulations

Sports Per Day Limit

- Athletes will be allowed to enter a total of five sports, one sport per day.
- Team events (3-on-3 basketball and volleyball) do not count toward the five-sport limit.

Division II Athletes

- Division II athletes may not compete in individual sports where through elimination they may end up competing head-tohead with a Division I athlete. These sports are:
 - Badminton
 - Basketball
 - Table Tennis
 - Tennis
 - Volleyball

Doubles and Mixed Doubles

- Doubles partners must be from the same division e.g. male/male, female/female.
 Division I athletes cannot partner with Division II athletes.
- Mixed doubles is restricted to same division, male/female partners.
 Division I athletes cannot partner with Division II athletes for mixed doubles.

Financial Aid and Fundraising



The costs associated with the Transplant Games are the responsibility of each attendee

Expected Cost Breakdown

Registration:

\$160 - \$200 (Competitor); **\$50 - \$75** (Non-Competitor)

Ages 6-10 is discounted 50%; Ages 5 and Under - Free

Flights:

Avg: \$400 round trip from PHL to BHM (plus \$100 baggage)

Two daily nonstop flights from PHL to BHM \$100 parking/travel to airport

Hotel:

\$237 per night (including tax); total for 6 nights is \$1,422

Food:

Based on \$74/day for 6 days

Estimated Total:

\$2,600 (competitors); **\$2,500** (non-athletes)

Team Philly Financial Assistance

<u>Individuals eligible for financial assistance:</u>

- Team Athletes (i.e. recipients or living donors)
 Guardians of athletes under the age of 18 can request
 financial assistance
- Family members of deceased organ, tissue or cornea donors (up to 4 per family)

Requesting financial assistance does not guarantee that assistance will be provided. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

All applications are due by March 1, 2024, no exceptions.
