


- Non-Profit OPO/Tissue Recovery/Eye Bank
- Established in 1974
- Federally designated OPO (Medicare) for eastern PA, Southern NJ & Delaware
 - 121 Acute Care Hospitals
 - 12 Transplant Centers, 34 Programs
 - 11.3 Million Population
- **664 organ donors in 2024, resulting in 1,671 organ transplants** (58 donors/MM and 145 transplants/MM); 2,732 tissue donors, including 1,350 musculoskeletal donors and 2,335 cornea donors
- **More than 60,000 organs coordinated for transplantation** and over 2,000,000 tissue allografts
- Contributed Most Donors & Organs for Transplant of all OPOs to the U.S. System Since Inception


- 24 hour on-call assistance and on-site response to evaluate and manage potential organ donors

- The Transplant Pregnancy Registry International (TPR) joined the Gift of Life Institute early February 2013
- Established in 1991 by Dr. Vincent T. Armenti to study the outcomes of pregnancies in female organ transplant recipients and those fathered by male organ transplant recipients
- 3,000+ recipients of kidney, liver, liver-kidney, pancreas, heart, lungs, and small bowel have participated in study

Who is an Athlete?

- Division 1: Solid Organ Transplant Recipients
- Division 2: Living Donors, Cornea, Tissue, Bone Marrow & Stem Cell Recipients
- Division 3: Donor Family Members & Living Donor Family Members
- To compete, a competitor's most recent transplant, or donation must have occurred on or prior to September 18, 2025
- Any age or athletic ability welcome!



Athlete Rules and Regulations

Sports Per Day Limit

- Athletes will be allowed to enter a total of one sport per day.
- Team events (3-on-3 basketball and volleyball) do not count toward the one sport limit.

Division 2 & 3 Athletes

- Division 2 & 3 athletes may not compete in individual sports where through elimination they may end up competing head-to-head with a Division 1 athlete. These sports are:
 - Badminton
 - Basketball
 - Table Tennis
 - Tennis
 - Volleyball

Doubles and Mixed Doubles

- Doubles partners must be from the same division e.g. male/male, female/female. Division 1 athletes cannot partner with Division 2 athletes.
- Mixed doubles is restricted to same division, male/female partners. Division 1 athletes cannot partner with Division 2 athletes for mixed doubles.




